STRIVE: nationally recognized, 4-week work readiness training program designed to help participants enter, re-enter or advance in the workplace. STRIVE's "tough love" approach helps build confidence for the job search and determine individual employment goals. Includes basic Digital / Financial Literacy skills.



Construction Ready: 4-week construction training program in partnership with CEFGA. Graduates receive up to 8 nationally-recognized credentials and have been employed with Atlanta's leading construction companies on major development projects including the Mercedes-Benz Stadium, State Farm Headquarters, Atlanta BeltLine, etc.



Literacy/GED Prep: An adult program in partnership with Atlanta Public Schools, designed to improve workforce literacy including reading and mathematics, as well as preparation for the GED exam.



Certified Nurse Assistant: 3-week course designed to prepare participants for entry-level positions in healthcare. Training includes classroom work and practical exercises in a simulated medical setting. All graduates are eligible to sit for the State CNA exam.



Coaching: each participant is paired with a Pathway Coach who works one on one to assist with identifying goals and priorities, matching strengths, career interest and experience with real opportunities, and connection to critical supportive services.



Microsoft Office Operations: 6-week course focused on core Microsoft applications, with emphasis on Word and Excel to meet marketplace demands. Graduates who qualify take the Microsoft Specialist certification exam, which can assist in securing employment with a higher level of pay.

Screenings: Free screening and recertification onsite for more than 21 public income supports including TANF, Medicare, PeachCare, Food Stamps and more. Available M-F, year-long.

Lead Safe Atlanta: Free home inspections for health and safety hazards including lead and other triggers. Small home repairs related to lead-based paint. Available by appointment only.

VITA: Free tax preparation onsite for persons earning \$54,000 and below during 2016. Prior year returns prepared as well. Available M-F, Jan-April 2017.
