## Required:

- Each individual teacher bringing a class of students is required to complete the application and attend a Saturday pre-mission training prior to the scheduled Micronaut or Challenger Learning Center mission date. 6 CPE hours will be provided after the training. No pre-program training is required for the planetarium presentations.
- Awards are granted until the funded missions have been awarded for identified groups of students, the teacher
  and one other ISD supervising adult. When all missions and presentations have been awarded, the application
  process closes. Additional parent chaperones are encouraged. There are no additional mission fees for their
  participation.
  - -Beyond the 32 students & 3 adults grouping, additional participant fees for planetarium programs are charged at \$4/child and \$5/adult.
- Up to two grants from this source may be awarded to a school and not to be combined with a mission and planetarium award.
- Each teacher will complete an exit survey reflecting on his or her experience in the Scobee Education Center.
