Practice Profile: Rutherford Health Center Delivers Collaborative Treatment Protocol for High-Risk Patients

Rutherford Health Center is a CCPN practice and a Federally Qualified Health Center in western North Carolina. The practice is approaching quality improvement through new external collaborations and internal protocols targeting their highest-risk patients.

Patients with multiple emergency department (ED) visits, two medical comorbidities, a behavioral health diagnosis and a social determinant of health have been identified as high-risk for the purposes of this intensive level of intervention.

Practice Manager Stephanie Hill has created a community workgroup consisting of the local hospital's Director of Case Management and hospital Community Liaison, a pharmacy representative, the local CCNC Carolina Community Health Partnership Behavioral Health Coordinator, and Rutherford Health Center's physician quality champion. This collaborative group meets regularly to develop strategies to provide key community resource information to patients and other community providers.

At Rutherford Health Center, Dr. David Bate, Medical Director, and Stephanie have created pop-up alerts in the EMR which notify the medical provider, the practice's care team and Stephanie when a high-risk patient has an appointment at the practice. Patient referrals and transportation needs are closely monitored and telephonic appointment reminders are sent to high-risk patients. The practice has

established new communication strategies with the hospital for these targeted patients as well. Rutherford Health Center also offers behavioral health services, and all efforts are made to schedule physical health and behavioral health appointments on the same day.

Additionally this practice is part of CCNC's Practice Transformation Network (PTN) under the Transforming Clinical Practice Initiative. Through the CCNC Carolina Community Health Partnership network, the PTN coach works closely with Stephanie on implementing quality improvement initiatives.

The primary goal of these quality improvement activities is to improve patient outcomes through adherence with primary care. Anticipated results include a reduction in ED visits, better patient compliance with scheduled office visits, increased medication adherence and enhanced collaboration with behavioral health services.

A total of 1,326 clinicians in 383 practices are a part of the Community Care Physician Network as of 11/30/2016. For a list of practices see below and on the following pages. Note, practices with multiple office locations are listed just once.


