

Hygiene: Soap, Toothpaste, Deodorants, Shampoo, **Toilet paper**, Hairbrushes, Q-tips (small containers), Clorox wipes (small containers), Lotion, Shaving Cream, Razors, Laundry detergent, Towels & Washcloths.

Baby: **Baby wipes**, Diapers (newborn, size 6), Baby wash, Baby food/cereal/formula.

Kitchen: Trash bags (45, 60 gal. heavy duty), Ziploc bags (gallon, quart)

Food Items: Hamburger Helper, Rice, Macaroni & Cheese, Stuffing, Canned meats (tuna, chicken), Breakfast cereal, Chef Boyardee, Peanut butter and jelly, Canned fruit.

Clothing: Blankets, Socks, Gloves, Winter coats.


