FRANCE FREEZES IRANIAN ASSETS OVER PARIS BOMB PLOT THWARTED BY MOSSAD

France said Tuesday that it had frozen assets belonging to Iran's intelligence services and two Iranians in response to an alleged plot to bomb a meeting of Iranian opposition supporters near Paris last June, the Times of Israel noted. The plot was reportedly thwarted by Israel's Mossad spy agency. "This extremely serious act envisaged on our territory could not go without a response," France's interior, foreign and economy ministers said in a rare joint statement. "In taking this decision, France underlines its determination to fight against terrorism in all its forms, particularly on its own territory," they added. The decree announcing the asset freezes on Iran's ministry of security and intelligence and on two Iranian men was published in the government gazette. [...] The Mossad, in conjunction with its counterparts from Belgium, France, and Germany, led a hunt that crossed several European borders and prevented the bombing, Hadashot TV news reported last month, without giving sources. The operation included tracking the suspects and eavesdropping on them, the report said.
