### ISRAELI EXPERTS ON SCENE IN WAKE OF PITTSBURGH SHOOTING

Following a mass shooting at a Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, synagogue on Saturday in which 11 people were killed and six injured, volunteers from two Israeli groups stepped up to help, Israel21c reported.

ZAKA International Rescue Unit Chief Officer Mati Goldstein reported in Jerusalem that he was in phone contact with ZAKA Commander in Pittsburgh Rabbi Elisar Adom overnight. Adom, who was an active ZAKA volunteer in Israel before moving to America, gathered ZAKA Search and Rescue USA volunteers at the Tree of Life synagogue to recover human remains and prepare them for a proper burial, in cooperation with the local emergency forces and FBI and in accordance with Jewish law.

"We grieve together with the Jewish community of Pittsburgh and pray for the full and speedy recovery of the wounded," said ZAKA Chairman Yehuda Meshi-Zahav in Jerusalem. "Our volunteers will also work with the community to offer assistance in all matters related to this tragic and horrific attack."
