

From northbound 270 – take the St. Charles Rock/Natural Bridge Rds. Exit and turn right

From westbound 70 – take the northbound 270 exit, then the St. Charles Rock/Natural Bridge Rds. Exit and turn right

From eastbound 70 – take the northbound 270 exit, then the St. Charles Rock/Natural Bridge Rds. Exit and turn right

Then take the St. Charles Rock Rd. East to McKelvey Rd and turn right. Turn right on De Paul Drive, then go left at first intersection to parking lot #3. If parking lot #3 is full, use lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9. If weather is inclement, you may find indoor routes to walk through DePaul Health Center Complex from the higher numbered lots.
