THE JAMES MILLER STUDENT AWARD 2017

APPLICATION FORM

The James Miller Student Award was established by the Trustees of the Mabel Harper Charitable Trust to commemorate the work of the late James Miller, architect of many important buildings in Scotland, including many mercantile buildings in central Glasgow, transport buildings including Wemyss Bay Station and Gleneagles Hotel. James Miller's work was the subject of a book published in 1991 by his daughter Mabel Harper. It is fitting that the trust established in her name wishes to commemorate her father with this award. It exists to support British architecture students from the Scottish Schools of Architecture who are studying in full or part time education on an approved course.

The Award is designed to assist British students who are facing hardship issues which affect their ability to complete all or part of their course. Students will be able to use the money to purchase any support necessary such as books, equipment or to assist with field trips.

The Trustees will also consider applications from students for assistance in the period following their year-out. This may include part funding of course fees for this period.

Timetable

For fairness, the Trustees have asked that we restrict the application period to run from the start of the new academic year each autumn until the end of November (Thursday 30th this year). Awards will be notified before the end of the year.

Entry

Submissions should comprise a complete award application form accompanied by a letter of support from the Head of Architecture or senior tutor at the University and completed RIAS Student membership application form (if the applicant is not already a member).

Amount of Award

The level of awards is at the discretion of the judges, based on the assessment of each individual application. The judges also reserve the right not to make any award during the year.
