Paying Property Taxes: Dates to Remember

Own property in Jessamine County? You'll want to know all about the relevant dates shared by Jessamine County Sheriff Kevin Corman in the list below:

October 31: Your Jessamine County property tax bill was mailed on this date.

November 1-30: Property tax bills paid or postmarked on or before November 30 receive a 2 percent discount.

December 1-January 2: Property tax bills paid or postmarked from December 1 through January 2 may be paid at face value (no discounts or penalties applied).

January 3-31: A 5% penalty will be applied to the face value of your tax bill if it is paid between January 3-31.

February 1-April 16: An additional 21 percent penalty will be applied to the December (face) total if taxes are paid between February 1-April 16.

Property tax bills may be paid online at JessamineSheriff.org by echeck or credit card. Payments may also be made during JCSO office hours (extended November and December hours are M-F 8 AM - 4 PM and SAT 8 AM-Noon). A drop box is also available outside the JCSO building, 101 S. Second Street, Nicholasville.

Did You Know?

* Residents who are 65 years or older and/or have a disability are eligible for a Homestead Exemption (a deduction from the assessed value of their primary residence). To apply or get more info, call the Jessamine County PVA Office: 859-885-4931.
