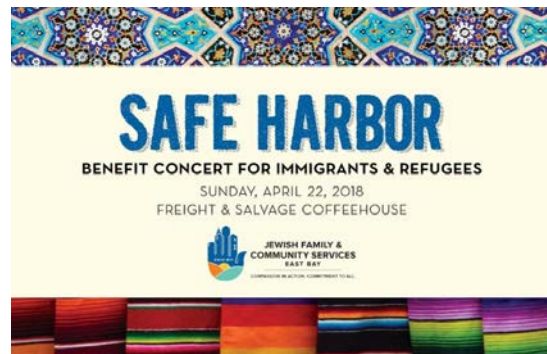
## Safe Harbor
