Position Overview

TampaBay-Job-Links (TBJL) is looking to add a part-time, professional Career Coach to our team. The Career Coach will be responsible for guiding clients in identifying short and long-term career goals and for creating realistic job-search and career plans. Clients include, but are not limited to: individuals in mid-career transition, women re-entering the workforce after a hiatus, military veterans transitioning to the civilian workforce, recent college graduates launching their careers, and mature workers not ready or able to retire.

Responsibilities

The Career Coach will:

- Work one-on-one with clients guiding them through their job search from start to finish.
- Work with clients in various stages of their career development and job-search process.
- Teach clients to utilize current job search strategies.
- Guide and assist clients in developing relevant job-search skills, such as preparing effective résumés and cover letters, and practicing interviewing and networking techniques, and utilizing social media in job search activities.
- Evaluate clients' interests, aptitude, education, experience, and skill levels for the purpose of identifying appropriate career directions.
- Help clients identify suitable employment opportunities.
- Identify any barriers or challenges to employment.
- Maintain case records in a timely manner.
- Prepare reports, and collect statistical data when necessary.
- Maintain and update professional skills through coursework and seminars; actively participate in in-service training sessions and in professional community programs.
- Present material, and facilitate small group programs and workshops.

Experience and Qualifications

- The ideal Career Coach candidate will have an outplacement, HR recruiting, or staffing company background with a focus on career coaching within the last two years.
- A bachelor's degree and a minimum of three years of career counseling or certified career coaching experience.
- Résumé writing experience is required. Certification preferred.
- Experience working with diverse populations and their challenges is preferred.
- Experience with career and personality testing desirable.
