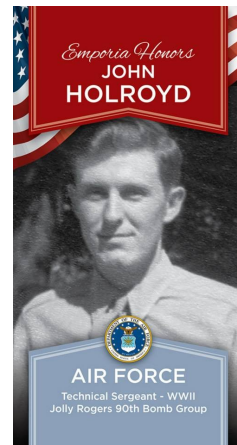




Veteran's Banner Project
