S.M. KIWANIS CLUB MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP FINAL AUDITIONS

1. Each participant must attend a Santa Monica-Malibu middle or senior high school and be a regular member of an official school-performing musical organization.
2. Participants must have been selected by the school music teacher in preliminary auditions.
3. Each participant is to choose his/her own music but must be approved by the student's music teacher.
4. A maximum time limit of 5 minutes must be observed by each competing finalist (students are urged to edit their music to meet this limit).
5. Each participant must furnish his/her own accompanist.
6. Every contestant must provide one copy of the music performed for the adjudicator.
7. The music need not be memorized, although memorization is advisable, especially for vocalists.
8. Competent adjudicators from outside of the district will judge all finalist participants. Their decision is final.
9. First-place winners will perform at the Santa Monica Women's Bay Club (1210 Fourth St. Santa Monica, CA 90401). There is a public parking structure next to the Santa Monica Women's Bay Club for your convenience. Seating for the performances will begin at 4:30 and the program will begin promptly at 5 pm. The reception will follow at the end of the program, approximately 7 pm.
10. Second and third-place winners will attend the Kiwanis Club Finalist Performance and Reception, as guests of the Kiwanis Club to receive their scholarships, but will not perform.

IMPORTANT: If chosen for any award, students will be held accountable to district policy concerning attendance. If a student fails to attend the award ceremony they must have a valid excuse. The excuse must be cleared by the Visual & Performing Arts Coordinator, Tom Whaley at 310 450-8338, x70287. The funds for these awards do not come easily and it is expected that students reflect this by thanking the Santa Monica Kiwanis Club upon receiving the award in person.

11. A previous middle school first-place winner may not compete again while in middle school but may compete in high school. A previous senior high school first place winner cannot compete again in the same grade 9-10 or 11-12 divisions.
12. Instrumentalists must perform on an approved orchestra or band instrument. Piano and guitar are not accepted in these auditions.
