### **Description:**

Camp Mariner is a school retreat where kids will grow educationally and spiritually by looking into the past as well as the current world around us. Children will go on educational tours and experiences that are based on content studied during the school year. Students will also have free time, group activities, and devotional/worship times at Camp. Some historic sites and educational sites we will visit may include Ft Caswell, Ft Fisher, Maritime Museum, Smith town cemetery, Historic Southport, NC Aquarium, Peanut plantation, and the USS NC battleship depending on your child's grade. A detailed itinerary for your child's grade level will be provided to families attending the trip.

Students will need to eat breakfast before coming to school and bring a bag lunch on May 24<sup>th</sup> for the trip to Ft Caswell. Students will also need a beach towel, towel for showering, twin sheets, & a sleeping bag in addition to clothing and toiletries. A complete packing list with instructions will be provided to families attending the trip.

Camp Mariner is a fun retreat for students to play, learn, and worship together. Be sure your Mariner does not miss out on this exciting trip.
