CONSTRUCTION CAREER DAY: The 2nd Annual Northern Nevada Construction Career Day was bigger and better! Organized by the principles of BuildNV.org, this event saw over 800 students participate in hands-on activities provided by over 50 exhibitors. The Las Vegas Construction Career Day also had an attendance of over 800 students. These events would not be successful without our members' participation.



WOMEN'S COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIPS: Once again, the Women's Council awarded 4 scholarships to construction program students in the state's four community colleges. Students receive \$500 per semester to support their studies in construction-related courses of study.
