As the owner, direct employee of this business, or as the person generating the waste material, I certify that the above information is true and correct. I further certify that I am currently a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator pursuant to 40 CFR 261.5; that I will not generate more than 100 kg (220 lbs.) of hazardous waste or 1 kg (2.2 lbs.) of acute hazardous waste; nor accumulate more than 1,000 kg (2,200 lbs.) of hazardous waste in this calendar month; and that I will not deliver hazardous waste to this facility in any month in which I generate regulated quantities.

I understand that it is my responsibility to comply with all applicable Federal, State, and local regulations concerning hazardous waste management. I further understand that if I do not meet all of the requirements, or generate hazardous waste in quantities greater than that specified in 40 CFR 261.5, and PA 451, 1995, Part 111, R 299.9205, I will no longer qualify as the Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator, and can no longer use this service. Acceptance of these materials is solely at the Grand Traverse County RecycleSmart's discretion; this registration in no way obligates Grand Traverse County RecycleSmart to accept any amount of non-residential wastes. It is the generator's responsibility to notify Grand Traverse County RecycleSmart of any change in regulator status as outlined in 40 CFR 261.5 and PA 451, 1994, Part 111.

I understand that Grand Traverse County RecycleSmart allows for the disposal of up to 150 pounds of hazardous waste by a CESQG at a scheduled Grand Traverse County household hazardous waste collection event by appointment only. As a CESQG utilizing this disposal option, I will incur a \$1.30 per pound fee for hazardous materials above the 150 pound allowance.
