What is the 2018 Summer Youth Retreat?

The Summer Youth Retreat is a dynamic dharma experience based at the Jodo Shinshu Center designed to nurture Buddhism in daily life; address personal challenges as a 21st-century Buddhist youth; support each participant's development as a young Buddhist; provide opportunities to meet an array of BCA dharma teachers and meet new dharma friends from throughout BCA.

Activities will include:

- * Daily training in chanting and Hongwanji rituals; mindfulness and meditation
- * Homyo (Buddhist name) and Kieshiki (Affirmation)
- * Lectures on Buddhism and Jodo Shinshu; and their relevance to youth today
- * Interactive workshops on identity (ethnic, racial/multi-racial, gender, etc.); and other topics
- * Field trips to BCA historic pilgrimage sites, UC Berkeley tour, and SF Bay Area sites
- * Teen reflection circle
- * Yoga, calligraphy, cooking and much more
