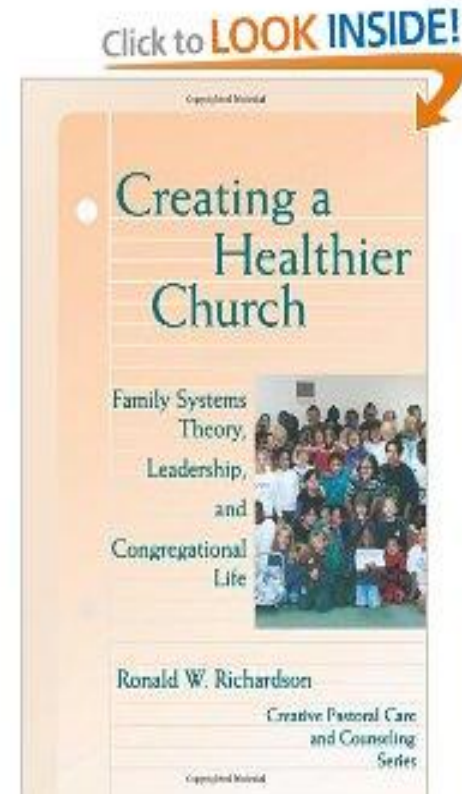

Clarification

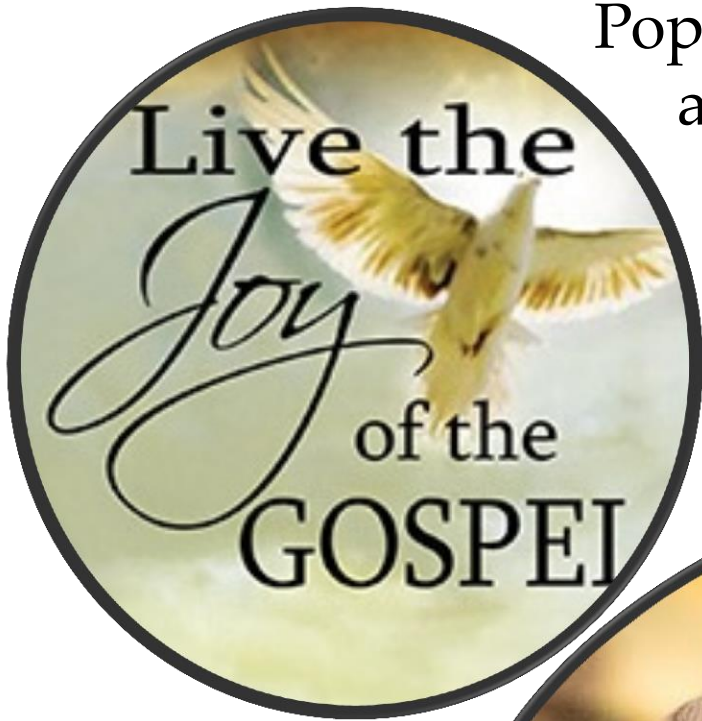

for you to do.

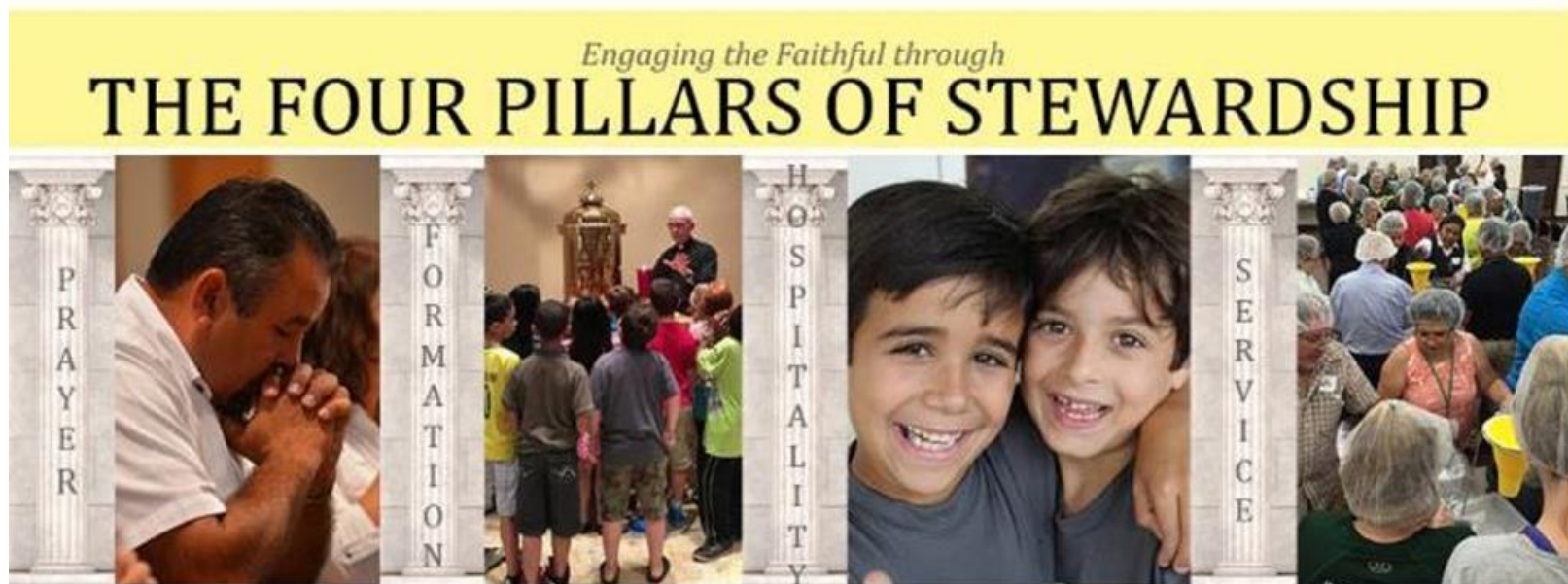
