Shredding limit: 3 medium sized boxes per household. **COSTS:** **Electronics, appliances and scrap metals recycling is \$5/car donation to BCHS Environmental Club; All other drop-offs for reuse, recycling and shredding is FREE. **OTHER NOTES:** Books will be collected for reuse or recycling by *Grassroot Givers*; monetary donations will also be gratefully accepted. Plastic toys will be sorted for reuse or recycling.

PLASTIC TOYS

Hard plastic toys in OK condition only

APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS, METALS*:
