Business Person of the Year

The Business Person of the Year recognizes the achievements and extraordinary community contributions of our local business leaders. Nominees epitomize the concerned and committed local business person, dedicating themselves to enhancing economic development in our community, and providing assistance or financial services to community groups, not-for-profit organizations or Bethlehem residents. Nominees should serve as a role model, consistently donating time and expertise to others. Nominees must be members in good standing of the Bethlehem Chamber, and have operated or represented a business in Bethlehem for a minimum of three years.

Citizen of the Year

Bethlehem's Citizen of the Year recognizes individuals who have made remarkable contributions to the quality of life in our community. The nominee may be any individual, couple, community group, or retired person. The nominee should exemplify civic community leadership, display high ethical and personal integrity, and demonstrate a commitment to voluntary service. Nominees must reside in Bethlehem for at least one year.

Community Spirit Award

The Community Spirit award recognizes an individual involved in a non-profit, business or other organization that has served the Bethlehem community. The nominee will have dedicated time and energy toward making Bethlehem a better place to live, work and play. The individual will have had a positive impact through their involvement in the community.

Lifetime Achievement Award

The Lifetime Achievement award recognizes a person or business in the community that has made positive contributions in business and in service to Bethlehem over a significant number of years. The nominee will have demonstrated long-term and significant business success and will have shown strong and active community involvement.

Youth Award

Bethlehem's Youth Award recognizes a young volunteer, entrepreneur or youth business venture for their contributions to the community. The nominee shall have performed outstanding service to the Bethlehem community and/or by their actions are excellent role models for their peers. Nominees must reside in Bethlehem for at least one year.

- Self-nominations and previous *nominees* are welcome.
- Nominees may not currently sit on the Chamber Board, be related to a Board Member or Chamber employee, or be a past recipient of a Chamber Award.
- The Chamber will present the appropriate awards annually, based on the Nomination Pool.
