

## CARETAKER SPOTLIGHT, ERIKA OVERSTREET, EVENT COORDINATOR

In this month's Caretakers Spotlight introduces you to Erika Overstreet, Event Coordinator for Event Services. Erika started working at Stanford in March 2015. She wanted to move to the Bay Area from Davis where she held a similar position at UC Davis. It was natural for Erika to stay at UC Davis after she graduated from the university with a double major of Art Studio and Psychology but she was ready for a change.

A typical workday for Erika consists of answering phone calls or emails, checking new and last minute event changes, entering data, talking to guests, giving advice on how to enter requests, and re-directing lost souls either on the phone or walk-ins to the Bonair Siding ES office. Erika is one of four coordinators who are there to help with all of your event needs from



8AM-5PM, Monday through Friday. While most of her job requires her to be in the office, she likes to mix things up and shadow various events as time permits. Erika spoke about her experience at Frost Music Festival 2016. She was able to shadow and see the event take place from "load in to the end of the festival. [One] can slowly see the space transform, especially when you look back through all the pictures." She called herself the "documentarian" for events. Once the space transforms, you have a deeper respect for the space and all of the work that takes place to plan and produce these events.

Erika was quick to say that she enjoys being able to think in a more creative style at ES. She explains that when you work with events, things can go wrong at the last minute, which is always an adrenaline rush, to say the least. thinking on her feet to get the issue solved. May and June are the busiest months for Events Services, although each month and Big Five events have their own challenges.
