Parking

St. Michaels University School

- Parking: the school is able to provide parking for those participants and facilitators traveling with a vehicle. We ask that you do not park in the reserved stalls located in proximity to the Boarding Residences. As it is summer time all other parking is open on a first come first serve basis.

What should I bring?

We recommend you bring the following:

- Casual summer clothing such as golf shirts, long pants, shorts and summer skirts. A sweater or light jacket for cool evenings
- Sports attire and equipment (workout). The following options are available: air conditioned fitness facility and non air conditioned gym. You may access these between 6am until 10pm. As well, there is a chip trail run located minutes from the school at a local golf course.
- We ask that dress pants and shirts or summer dresses be worn for the New Heads (Tuesday) and Graduation Dinners (Thursday).
- Sleepwear, housecoat, **bath/hand towels** and toiletries. The school will **NOT** have towels, so please do not forget this.
- A small fan for the room as there is no air conditioning in the residences.
- Each room can be locked and you will be provided with a key.
- Cash – there will be a cash bar.
 - Monday and Tuesday are nights traditional hospitality suites at the school.
 - Wednesday you are free to travel downtown - 10-15 minute cab or walk to the local pub if so desired
 - Thursday at the graduation celebration
- A camera to record your Institute moments
- Any school materials related to the curriculum offered
- Lots of energy and enthusiasm!

Accommodation and other key details

Please note:

- You are reminded that families do live on campus and the school is situated within a residential community. You are asked to respect our host school and community especially at quiet times.
- Within a 10-20 minute walk you have access to a variety of shopping, food and personal needs stores.
- All materials provided by facilitators will be available in digital format. Laptops and personal notebooks are recommended and you will have access to wifi in both the school and residences.
- Residence:

- will consist of rooms with 2 single beds. Each room has a bathroom and shower.
- There are common areas in each residence. Feel free to enjoy these areas.
- Alcohol may only be consumed in areas that the school has permits for (Hospitality Suites/Dining Hall). Liquor is not to be consumed in the dorms.
- Room keys. Each person will be given a key to their room and a swipe card to access the boarding house. You must return this on your last day to Don Kawasoe. Failure to return will result in a \$50 fee.
