Senate District 2, represented currently by Senator Norman Sanderson, will remain the same, which is Craven, Carteret & Pamlico Counties.

Pamlico County is currently in Rep. Michael Speciale's District 3, but starting next year, will be in District 6, which is currently represented by Beverly Boswell.
