The subject of this may be to take comment on the recently filed Petition for Rulemaking by the North Carolina Wildlife Federation regarding severe restrictions on shrimping, but as far as we're concerned, this is a referendum on the future of commercial fishing in North Carolina! Put this date on your calendar! Set aside the whole day for it! Again, the meeting begins at 12:30pm.
