Legislative Update

The North Carolina General Assembly will meet in special session next Tuesday, October 2nd, at noon. The specific purpose is to address some issues prior to meeting the following week that will deal with Hurricane Florence relief.

The session next week will address some policy issues, and then adjourn until October 9th to deal with the relief issues.

Senate President Pro Tem Phil Berger and House Speaker Tim Moore laid out the following priorities for October 2nd:

- Legislation assuring teachers and other education personnel that they will be paid for days schools were closed due to the hurricane.
- School calendar flexibility for systems that missed significant school time.
- Delaying small business tax deadlines Changing vehicle title replacement policies for
