Committee	Description	Committee	Description
<input type="checkbox"/> Caddie Services	Committee members will be asked to staff Caddie Registration on Thursday and Friday of Championship Week. During Championship Rounds, this committee will also distribute and collect Caddie bibs on the 1 st & 10 th tees, & the 9 th and 18 th greens. (I,O,L).	<input type="checkbox"/> Practice Range	Committee members will be responsible for assisting players at the Tournament practice facility with distribution of practice balls. Committee will require heavy lifting and physical activity. (O, L)
<input type="checkbox"/> Contestant Evacuation	Committee members will assist the PGA Rules Committee in evacuating Contestants and Caddies from the golf course (O).	<input type="checkbox"/> Scoring Control	Committee members receive Contestants' scores from the Walking Scorer and will electronically dispense them to Leaderboards, the Media Center and the Golf Channel Television compound (I, C).
<input type="checkbox"/> Golf Channel	Committee members work directly with the Golf Channel as spotter scorers, microphone operators in addition to other responsibilities. WORK ON THE GOLF CHANNEL COMMITTEE REQUIRES 4 DAYS OF VOLUNTEERING, 6 HOURS PER DAY, AND THE ABILITY TO WALK 18 HOLES (O).	<input type="checkbox"/> Player Shuttles	Committee members will shuttle Contestants from various locations on the golf course and to/from the practice facilities (O).
<input type="checkbox"/> Leaderboards	Committee members post Contestants' scores on Leaderboards located throughout the golf course. Leaderboards display the top eight (8) Contestants currently on the course and how they stand for both the day and Championship (O,C).	<input type="checkbox"/> Standard Bearers	Committee members are responsible for preparing standards (small scoreboards). Committee members will be responsible for carrying standards for each group of Contestants during the final 2 rounds of the Championship Rounds after the cut (O,OT, W).
<input type="checkbox"/> Tech Committee	Committee members help hand out walking scorer equipment and answer any last minute questions from walking scorers. Members will also help trouble shoot on course issues with walking scorers or leaderboards. This committee will also help as scorecard runners, and will be responsible for retrieving scorecards from scoring tents and delivering to PGA HQ.	<input type="checkbox"/> Tee Refreshments/ Ecology	Committee members will be responsible for distributing coolers of refreshments throughout the golf course. Coolers will also be replenished throughout the day and collected upon completion of play. In addition will assist in placing and picking up ecology containers and bags on property. Members will also be responsible for ensuring the course and spectator areas are free of trash. (O, L). WORK ON THE TEE REFRESHMENTS COMMITTEE IS VIGOROUS. SOME HEAVY LIFTING IS REQUIRED (O,OT, L).
<input type="checkbox"/> Marshals	Marshals will be assigned to various holes and areas of the golf course. They will assist with gallery control and assist contestants, caddies, officials (O).	<input type="checkbox"/> Volunteer Services	Committee members assist PGA staff with distributing volunteer uniforms and credentials during volunteer training days. Committee members will also be assigned to assist in the Volunteer Tent with distribution of uniforms, radios, and assisting other volunteers (OT, L).
<input type="checkbox"/> Public Score/ Summary Board	Committee members will assist a PGA Calligrapher with posting Contestants' names and scores on the Public Scoreboard. The Public Scoreboard is usually constructed in a common area for spectators to easily view (O,C).	<input type="checkbox"/> Walking Scorers	Walking Scorers will be assigned to walk with each group of Contestants and required to keep the scores and statistics for 3 players. YOU SHOULD BE KNOWLEDGEABLE OF GOLF AND HAVE EXPERIENCE AS A WALKING SCORER. (O, C, W).

Key: (C) Computer use; (I) Assignment is indoors in a climate controlled; (O) Assignment is outdoors, potential for varied weather conditions; (OT) Assignment is outdoors, but in a tent — NOT climate controlled; (L) Heavy lifting required** (W) Ability to walk 18 holes at a brisk pace.
