2 **"Section 737.____.** (A) There is hereby created the Ohio Lead
3 Legislative Study Group to study lead poisoning treatment and
4 control issues and propose a plan to address those issues. The
5 Group shall include all of the following participants:

6 (1) The chairs of the committees of the House of
7 Representatives and the Senate with a primary responsibility
8 over health and education issues;

9 (2) The ranking minority members of the committees of the
10 House of Representatives and the Senate with a primary
11 responsibility over health and education issues;

12 (3) A representative from each of the following
13 organizations appointed by the Governor:

14 (a) Advocates for Basic Legal Equality;

15 (b) American Academy of Pediatrics, Ohio Chapter;

16 (c) Building Environment Council of Ohio;

17 (d) Children's Defense Fund;

18 (e) Coalition on Homelessness and Housing in Ohio;

19 (f) Cleveland Lead Safe Network;

- (g) Corporation for Ohio Appalachian Development;
- (h) Environmental Health Watch;
- (i) Healthy Homes Advisory Council of Greater Cleveland;
- (j) Marion County Public Health;
- (k) Ohio Association of Community Action Agencies;
- (l) Ohio Environmental Health Association;
- (m) Ohio Federation for Health Equity and Social Justice;
- (n) Ohio Healthy Homes Network;
- (o) Ohio Nurses Association;
- (p) Ohio Poverty Law Center;
- (q) Ohio Public Health Association;
- (r) People Working Cooperatively;
- (s) The Kirwan Institute for the Study of Race and Ethnicity at The Ohio State University;
- (t) Toledo Lead Poisoning Prevention Coalition.
- (4) Nicholas Newman, Assistant Professor at the University of Cincinnati Department of Pediatrics.
- (B) The Governor shall make appointments to the Group not later than thirty days after the effective date of this section. The chair of the committee of the Senate with primary responsibility for education issues shall serve as the initial chair of the Group. However, not later than ninety days after the Group's first meeting, the Group shall elect a chair to serve for the remainder of the Group's mandate.

44 (C) Not later than one year after the effective date of
45 this section, the Ohio Lead Legislative Study Group shall submit
46 a report of its findings and recommendations to the Speaker and
47 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives and the
48 President and Minority Leader of the Senate.
