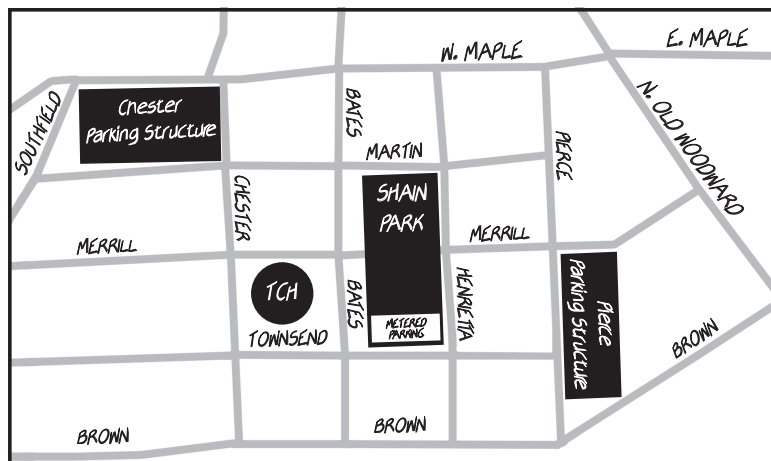

## **SHIRLEY STANCATO**

President & CEO, New Detroit, Inc.

Shirley R. Stancato is president and chief executive officer of New Detroit, southeastern Michigan's only leadership coalition devoted solely to race relations, serving as an essential forum for discussion and advocacy for racial equity.

Under Stancato's leadership, New Detroit convenes a bi-annual regional leadership summit on race, organizes an annual summer business camp for youth, conducts a multicultural leadership program, supports a financial literacy curriculum in local schools, and provides comprehensive technical assistance for small non-profit organizations.

Prior to joining New Detroit in 2000, Stancato's career spanned 30 years at what is now Chase Bank, where she became senior vice president. A lifelong Detroit resident, Stancato earned bachelor's and master's degrees from Wayne State University.

She is a board member of the Coleman A. Young Foundation, Detroit Symphony Orchestra, United Way for Southeastern Michigan, the Detroit Institute of Arts, St. John Health and Fifth Third Bank Eastern Michigan Board. In 2008 she was named Michiganiaan of the Year by The Detroit News. Stancato is the chair emeritus of Alternatives for Girls and past chair of the board of the Detroit Urban League.

New Detroit's mission is to work as the coalition of Detroit area leadership addressing the issue of race relations by positively impacting issues and policies that ensure economic and social equity.
