Nord Corridor & South Campus Business Walk And Community Safety Meeting


72 Businesses Visited | 1 Business Walk | 8 Team members | 1 Community Safety Meeting

Business Feedback: The Team asked standard Business Walk questions such as: "Tell us what it's like doing business in this area." "Do you have any concerns about doing business here?" We also asked for feedback and observations on traffic, congestion, safety, and general business climate/health issues:



- Transients: Businesses reported issues with just an
 increase in transients in general, loitering, defecating and urinating in store doorways, and transients
 passed out outside businesses during business hours.
- **Cleanliness**: Businesses reported issues with graffiti and transients/students leaving trash around their businesses.
- **Security/Safety of Businesses & Properties:** Businesses reported issues with non-customer cars being left in business parking lots, theft / break-ins, vandalism, thieves working in pairs, and physical attacks.
- **Streets/Parking:** Businesses reported issues with Cedar Street specifically which has not been maintained and needs work.

COMMUNITY SAFETY MEETING – September 7, 2017



- Bike Path Safety Camera Project a success not one significant violent crime on the bike path since the cameras were installed.
- MOU, between the California State University, Chico and the City of Chico, is another success of these meetings.
- 3 existing Park Rangers will now be sworn Park Rangers, under Chico PD
- Chief Reid is new interim Chico State COP and apart of the Critical Response Unit, specially trained officers that deal with crowd control issues.
- CalTrans putting in roundabout at Nord and West Sacramento Ave, as well as

additional signals in area

- City of Chico received grant to put in bike lanes on Walnut.
- Will they be connecting the gaps in the paved sidewalks on Nord? Yes. As well as ADA compliance.
- Transients stocking apartments & Chico PD recommend calling the Target Team about this specifically.
- The Depot Park has problems, can we get flood lights? The City will research.
- There is bike education being done at California State University, Chico, during orientation, but Chico PD is also doing on the street education. Public Health wants to partner with Chico State to put on classes on biking in Butte County. Chico State should also do more social media education on bike regulations.
- Bike stores not required to register bikes but some are now starting to do with bike sales.
