2017 Junior Golf Program

1. **PROGRAM OVERVIEW:** The Whitewater Country Club Junior Golf Program is for golfers between the ages of 8 and 17. The program is intended to increase juniors' interest and skill in the game of golf, and knowledge of golf rules and etiquette. All Juniors will walk the course when playing.
2. **PROGRAM DATES/TIMES:** The Junior Golf Program **OPEN HOUSE** will begin on Monday, June 5th (5 PM TO 7 PM) and continue every Monday throughout the summer starting June 12 until (skipping July 3rd) Monday, August 8th. The program has exclusive use of the course from 8:00 a.m. until noon on these dates. The Buffet Lunch and Awards Ceremony will be held at Noon to 2pm on August 13th.
3. **REGISTRATION INFO & DEADLINE:** Participation in 2017 Junior Golf Instruction Program, being held on Monday mornings from June 12 through August 13, will have a fee of \$57.50. To register go to www.whitewater-wi.gov , then go to Departments and find "Parks & Recreation". Look for code 1401-21 – Junior Golf Instruction. Registration will only be taken by Whitewater Parks and Recreation. All Country Club applications and Jr. Golf Program forms must be turned in to Whitewater Country Club prior to the first class. **DEADLINE: June 5, 2017.**
4. **PROGRAM COST:** The cost of the Junior Golf Program is **\$57.50**. A Junior Golf Program Application is located in this information packet. Additionally, a WCC Junior Membership must be purchased for **\$158.25 (includes tax)** if the junior is not already covered by a family membership. State sales taxes apply.
5. **LESSONS:** Juniors will be placed into lesson groups based on their age and experience. Lessons will be scheduled between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
6. **WALKERS:** We are asking that all parents/guardians sign up for 1 or 2 days to walk the course with the junior members. Walkers are vital to the program and ensure that juniors are displaying proper golf etiquette and safety on the course at all times. Walkers also supervise the activities and make sure that games are being played properly.
7. **LUNCH:** Lunch, Soft drinks and water are available in the Clubhouse but are not included in the fee.
8. **PICK-UP.** Juniors must be picked up no later than **12:15** every Monday. Please notify the coordinator if your child will be picked up by someone other than a parent or grandparent.
9. **RAIN OUTS:** Please call 473-3305 (Club House) after 8:00am on rainy days to determine if the program will be cancelled for that day.
10. **MAKE UP RAIN DAYS:** If lessons are rained out (Lightning and/or heavy rain), open play for Juniors might still be available later in the afternoon. Call Ron (262-203-3247) for details.
11. **Junior/Parent 2-Ball Tournament:** The 2-ball tournament round may be played at any time the course is open to Junior Members between July 9th and August 6th. All score cards must be turned in by the morning of August 7th. Sorry no exceptions. Rules for the tournament will be sent out via e-mail before July 9th. Parent joining the Junior Golfer will get a free golf pass for the 9 holes.
12. **AWARDS BANQUET:** The end-of-the-season Awards Banquet will be held on Sunday, August 13th from Noon to 2:00 PM. Awards will be given for the various events that are played throughout the season. More information will be provided as that date approaches.

**June 5
Open House**

Participants register at the Whitewater Country Club from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

**June 12
Least # of Putts**

On the course, players will keep track of the number of putts they have on each hole. The junior in each lesson group with the least number of putts for their round will be recognized at the Awards Banquet.

**June 19
Medal Play I**

Low total scores in each lesson group will be recognized at the Awards Banquet.

**June 26
Alternating Shots**

The Junior golfer will be randomly teamed up with another junior in their division and alternate shots to determine the team score for each hole. Winning teams will be recognized at the Awards Banquet.

July 3

No lessons – HAPPY 4TH OF JULY WEEKEND

**July 10
Flag Holes**

Certain holes will have specific competitions on them, such as longest drive, longest putt made and closest to the pin. Winners in each lesson group will be recognized at the Awards Banquet.

**July 17
Medal Play II**

Low total scores in each lesson group will be recognized at the Awards Banquet.

**July 24
Scramble**

No lessons are scheduled for this date. All golfers must be at the club by 7:45am. Juniors will be divided into teams. Each team member will hit a tee shot and the best drive is selected. Other team members will move their balls to the selected drive and play their second shot from this location. This process will continue until the ball is holed out. Winning teams will be recognized at the Awards Banquet.

**July 31
Skills Challenge**

Juniors will display their skills as tests are set up to challenge them in various aspects of the game such as putting, chipping, etc. Awards will be given according to lesson groups. This is a one day event only.

**August 7
Rain day make-up**

Event to be played will depend on which previous date was rained out. If no make-up is needed we will have open play at normal lesson times.

August 13

Noon to 2 PM. Our annual buffet lunch and awards ceremony.

Rules and Regulations

1. **JUNIOR MEMBERSHIPS:** All juniors who are not included in a family membership must purchase a junior membership. The cost of a junior membership is \$158.25 (includes tax). A Junior Golf Membership Application is located at the end of this information packet.
2. **2017 JUNIOR GOLF INSTRUCTION FEE:** The fee is \$57.50 with checks made out to the City of Whitewater. To register go to www.whitewater-wi.gov, then go to Departments and find “Parks & Recreation”. Look for code 1401-21 – Junior Golf Instruction. Sign up there as soon as available or drop off at the Whitewater Country Club. **DEADLINE: June 5, 2017.**
3. **COURSE RULES:** All course rules will be in effect during the Junior Golf Program. **All Juniors will walk the course when playing.**
4. **USGA RULES:** USGA Rules shall govern the play during the Junior Golf Program. These rules will be reviewed during the program and juniors may be periodically tested on them.
5. **EQUIPMENT:** All junior golfers are required to have clubs, balls, tees, a ball marker, and a divot repair tool. Let Ron Binning (262-203-3247) know ahead of time if Clubs are needed. We will try to make arrangements.
6. **SCORECARDS:** Make sure your name and lesson time is on your scorecard before you turn it in at the clubhouse.
7. **CARTS:** No junior members may drive a cart during the Junior Golf Program. Adult Walkers supervising juniors on the course may drive a cart but all Juniors will walk.
8. **GOLF ETIQUETTE:** Proper golf etiquette is required at all times. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - No metal spikes or cleats may be worn on the course.
 - No vulgar language, throwing clubs, or anything else that may be deemed as poor sportsmanship.
 - Replace divots in the fairway, rake sand traps, repair ball marks on the green, and replace the flag in the cup after putting out.
 - Stay well behind and off to the side of a player teeing off.
 - Never walk in front of a person swinging or hitting.
 - Do not hit into the group ahead of you.
 - Allow faster groups to play through, but only from the tee.
9. **JUNIOR MEMBER HOURS OF PLAY:** Besides the Junior Golf Program hours, junior members 14 years or older may play during any time open to all regular members. Junior members 13 years and younger must be accompanied by a person who is at least 16 years of age. They may play during any time open to all regular members Monday through Friday. **Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, junior members 13 years and younger may only play after 2:00 pm.** Please call ahead, as hours of play are subject to change due to tournaments or other events.
