Under close supervision from our veterinarian Dr. Reidenbach, Ebony's activity was kept mellow with only 2 to 3 gentle walks per day - yet she still found ways to keep busy! She tried desperately to charm her foster mom's "large, grumpy cat" and took a special interest in trying to sample the cat's kibble whenever the opportunity arose. She also learned "sit", nearly perfected her adorable "wave" cue and made friends with an older dog. Her foster mom describes her as "a class act... she's PERFECT".

Ebony is now back at SHS and officially available for adoption! She's currently on a medication to help her heart muscles damaged by the PDA, and her cardiologist recommends that her adopter bring her in for a follow-up echocardiogram in 3 months to determine if she needs to continue taking the medication. Dr. Reidenbach says "we are optimistic that Ebony will continue to do as well as she has following her surgery".

We can't wait to see what the coming days bring for this charming, sweet-natured terrier. We're excited that she'll soon be settling into a forever home, soaking up all the love, stability and companionship she deserves.
