site training and programming for athletes, as well as the administrative space and support needed for its expanding network of volunteers and staff.


TRAINING FOR LIFE will include:

- Space for FREE ATHLETE HEALTH SCREENINGS.
- 1,800 sq. ft. of WAREHOUSE SPACE to store our equipment and supplies for competitions, many sports camps and clinics.
- FULL BREAK ROOM for athletes, families, volunteers and staff.
- ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES to provide space to SOGA's volunteers, coaches and staff.
