A brief summary of his accomplishments follow.



In recognition of his activities spreading quality globally and activities related to helping companies to recover from FDA warning letters due to deficiencies in quality systems and ultimately to improve patient safety. He is an adjunct professor, teaching quality courses in the MSQA program at California State University Dominguez Hills and has taught Six Sigma class at California State University Pomona and as well as ASQ Certification courses for the Orange Empire Section, ASQ.

Mr. Mehta holds a MBA, Pepperdine University degree and a MSQA degree from California State University Dominguez Hills. He is an ASQ Fellow and holds eight ASQ Certifications. His volunteer activities with the Orange Empire Section during the past ten years include Section Chair, Vice Chair, Audit and currently as Career Chair. He has served as a speaker at the Southern California Quality Conference (SCQC) for the past seven years.

Publications include "Practical Process Validation", ASQ Press 2016 (co-author); chapters in the publication "The Certified Pharmaceutical GMP Professional Handbook, ASQ Press, (2014) and "Implementing ISO/IEC 17025:17005 –A Practical Guide", ASQ Press (2013).


