Each course will be taught using a Primer, which can be brought into the exam. Primers cost (\$60 - \$80) and are available from the Quality Council of Indiana at www.qualitycouncil.com.

Students are responsible for registering for the ASQ Exam prior to the Application Deadlines listed above. ASQ Exam Registration Fees are in addition to the class fees and are paid directly to ASQ.
