On April 11th, ASQLA will hold its meeting at the Cal State Dominguez Hills, College of Extended & International Education.

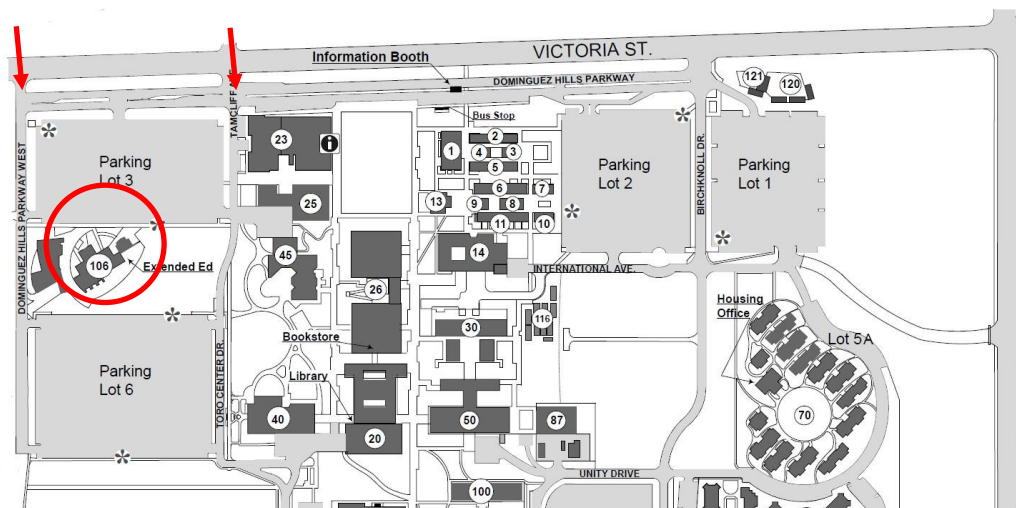

Courses will be conducted on Six (6) Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 1:30 PM at the Phenomenex Training Facility, located at **2341 West 205th Street, Torrance, CA 90501**. Each course will be 33 hours in length and a certificate for 3.3 (RU) Recertification Units will be awarded.
