

# FACULTY GRANTS IN FRANCE

Candidates from the faculties of colleges and universities in Southern California may apply for the following grants to be used in France during **summer of 2017** and **academic year 2017-18**:

## Semester (or Quarter) Scholar-in-Residency Grants in France

The Foundation offers grants combining (a) a stipend of \$30,000 for research in France for a semester (or quarter) during the **academic year 2017-18**, plus (b) accommodations in the **Château** (picture above) — with all furnishings provided and utilities paid — as a home base for the research and/or writing up the research findings. Out of academic and practical considerations, candidates should be on sabbatical leave. The Foundation expects a scholarly publication to derive from the grant.

## Grants to Host an International Colloquium in France

The Foundation offers grants of \$35,000 to academicians to organize and direct 3-day international colloquia in their academic fields at the Château de la Bretesche in the **summer months of 2017**. The Foundation funds several every summer. They should be small in size, with up to 12 participants equally divided between Americans / Europeans. The Foundation expects grantees to publish the proceedings.

## Applications

Candidates may be from any discipline. Grants have been made, for example, in French, English, art, music, theater, philosophy, psychology, history, economics, medicine, dentistry and so on.

**Candidates for Scholar-in-Residency grants for academic year 2017-18** shall submit an online application to [www.borchardcenter.org](http://www.borchardcenter.org) which includes: (1) résumé, (2) research proposal, (3) budget, and (4) department/administration endorsement no later than **October 15, 2016**. Candidates must demonstrate that a Scholarship-in-Residency in France is essential to their proposed project and academic career. Please indicate other available funding if not on sabbatical leave.

**Applicants for Colloquium grants for the summer of 2017** shall submit an online application to [www.borchardcenter.org](http://www.borchardcenter.org) which includes: (1) proposed colloquium topic, (2) list of proposed participants, and (3) draft budget—all no later than **October 15, 2016**. Candidates must demonstrate that a Colloquium in France is vital academically and that the interface with European peers is essential. Please call (below) for details before you apply.
