EDGP 776 Non-Degree Application Guidelines

Note: *If you have previously completed coursework at CUW, simply email graduate.admission@cuw.edu and ask to be registered for the course.*

1. Visit www.cuw.edu/apply
2. Begin by creating a Non-Degree Account. Note that you wish to enroll as a 'Continuing Education' student. When prompted to select license or courses, select 'Continuing Education Courses.'
3. Once you have created your account, you will be taken to your account home page. Scroll to the bottom and click on 'Start an Application' in the Next Steps box.
4. Select 'Start a new Non-Degree Application.' The information you submitted when creating your profile will automatically populate.
5. Follow the steps of the application, filling in any missing information. Always select 'Continuing Education Courses' when given the option.
6. When asked what course(s) you would like to take, type in the course number prefix and number (EDGP 776, CRN 13089). Indicate the number of credits you wish to take the course for.
7. In 5-7 business days, you will receive a confirmation email stating that you have been registered for the course. This email will provide you with your student ID number, which will allow you to log into the portal. This is where you will access your CUW email, billing information, transcripts, etc.
