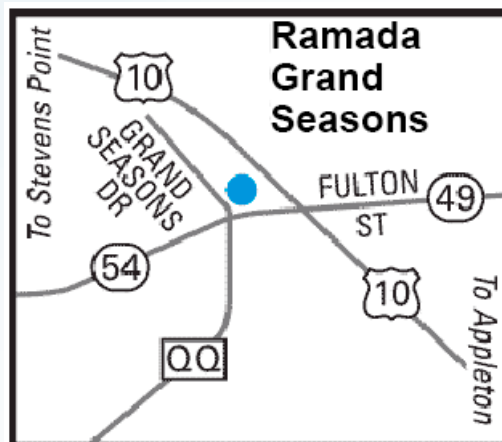

From the west: Take US10 east to first Waupaca exit (49/54W) to the Ramada Grand Seasons Hotel.



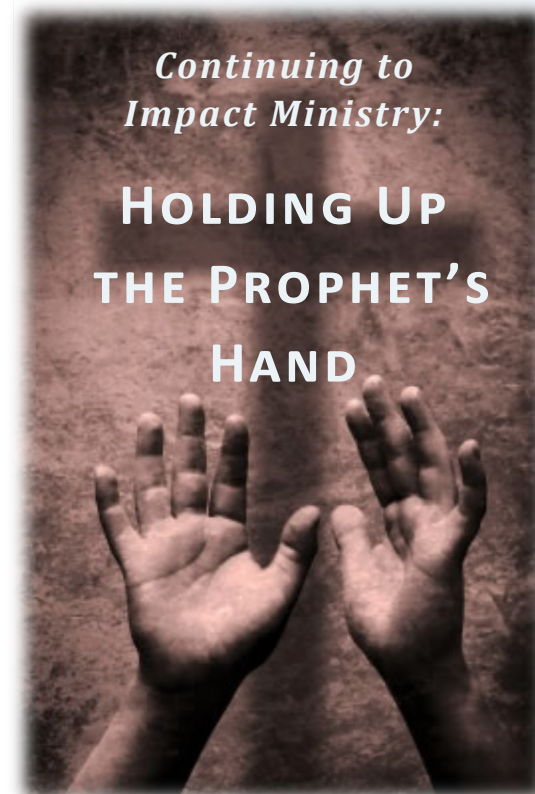
