



Joseph Prabhu: Co-Chair Southern CA Parliament of World's Religions (SCCPWR) Professor Emeritus Cal State Los Angeles, Adjunct Professor Claremont Graduate University & Emeritus trustee of the Global Parliament of the World's Religions

Devorah Brous: founding Executive Director of Netiya which empowers people to grow food on faith-based lands in LA. She spent 15 years designing campaigns to advance human rights, community self-reliance, and environmental justice in Israel and the Palestinian Territories.

Philip Clayton: President of Toward an Ecological Civilization and Ingraham Professor at Claremont School of Theology. His research focuses on biological emergence, religion & science, process studies, contemporary issues in ecology, religion, & ethics. He now researches societal changes that are necessary for establishing sustainable forms of civilization on this planet.

Mohammad Hoda: serves on the steering committee of California Interfaith Power and Light (CIPL) Mohammed advises the Islamic Shura Council of Southern California on environmental issues and serves on the board of an upcoming international Muslim climate change mitigation effort called Global Muslim Climate Network(GMCN).

MODERATOR: **John B. Cobb, Jr.** is an American philosopher, theologian, and environmentalist and is often cited as one of the most important North American eco-theologians of the twenty-first century. He is the preeminent scholar in the school of process thought associated with the philosophy of Alfred North Whitehead. The author of more than fifty books, Cobb is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences — one of the nation's highest honors.
