

Tips for Travelling to Trinidad & Tobago

Tobago is easily accessible from most major North American cities by several airlines. Direct flights can be found at most major airlines such as American, Copa , United, JetBlue, Virgin Atlantic, Southwest, Caribbean, and West Jet. There are still very few direct flights to Tobago's A.N.A. Robinson International Airport. Fortunately, Trinidad's *Piarco International Airport* (POS) handles a wide range of regional and international flights. For the cost of \$48.00 ROUND TRIP, a regular air bridge service operate by Caribbean Airlines provides a 25 minute transfer between the two islands and an inter-island ferry service may be of interest to some travelers, [www.mytobago.info/air travel](http://www.mytobago.info/air%20travel) . The airline runs a tight ship so allow for plenty of time to make connections. Once you arrive at Robinson International, it is a short taxi drive to Magdalena Grand Beach and Gold Resort.

If you can book a flight to Miami, Fort Lauderdale or Houston you can travel to Trinidad & and Tobago. It is advisable to make early reservations and allow time to make connecting flights.

American Airlines (AA), offers daily non-stop flights to Trinidad (POS) from Miami (MIA) with connections from New York (LGA) and Washington (BWI). Be sure to book a flight to (POS) that arrives early so that you can book a transfer on Caribbean Airlines to Tobago.

Caribbean Airlines (www.caribbean-airlines.com) is the national airline of Trinidad & Tobago. There is a non-stop weekly service from JFK in New York to Tobago. In addition the following services are available:

Miami (MIA) –Daily service to (POS),

New York (JFK) – Two non- stop flights to (POS) per day, with an extra flight on Sundays and Mondays,

Fort Lauderdale (FLL)—Daily non-stop flights to (POS).

United Airlines—offers flights from Chicago, Newark (EWR) and Houston (IAH). All flights from Houston are non-stop and also some of the flights from Newark, although others are via Houston.

JetBlue flies from Los Angeles, Boston, New York (JFK), Buffalo to Fort Lauderdale. Once in Fort Lauderdale a flight on Caribbean Airlines will get you to (POS).

West Jet (Canadian) operates a daily direct service between Toronto's Pearson International Airport and Tobago.
