



We offer Equine Assisted Psychotherapy (EAP), an experience-based psychotherapy treatment provided on its own or in conjunction with existing treatment.

We offer Equine Assisted Learning (EAL), a learning approach using experience-based interactions for development of educational, personal and professional life skills.
