

All other applicants will be placed on a waiting list to be contacted when space becomes available. **Registration Fee:** \$12 per child for the nine weeks. If two or more campers are from the same family the maximum registration fee will be \$18 for the entire family.\*\* All fees includes daily activities, educational materials and field trips. Three t-shirts will be required to be purchased for \$25. Camp HOPE fees **MUST** be **PAID IN FULL** by the first day of camp.

\*\*Camp fees are based upon a sliding fee scale as determined by the parents' income. Proof of income will be required (i.e. tax form 1040, 1040EZ, etc).\*\*

**Staff:** Adult supervision will be provided by camp staff and volunteers. All employees and volunteers are required to undergo a background security screening.

**Meals:** Camp HOPE will provide free breakfast, lunch, and snacks on a daily basis.
