

Q: What is the maximum amount of merit badges I can earn?

You can earn up to four badges. You may register for two Eagle merit badges, one Eagle merit badge + two non-Eagle merit badges, or four non-Eagle merit badges.

You must leave one period open for lunch period 3, 4, or 5. Note that Environmental Science merit badge extends into the 3rd period so you may not take a non-Eagle merit badge then if taking Environmental Science.

Q: Can I bring cell phones and other electronic devices to the college?

While having a phone is great to coordinate pick-ups and is helpful for some of our sessions, it is expected that all Scouts are Courteous. All electronic devices should be stored during class and placed on silent.



Q: Do I need to bring a lunch? What is the schedule for the day?



Please bring your lunch. Lunches can be consumed in the cafeteria on the first floor of the Technical High School which is clearly marked on the map.

Class rooms are listed in the columns of your schedule which will be given to you upon registration. There will be signage and guides to help you.

Check-in will start at 7:30 a.m. in the Cafeteria at the Technical High School .

The 8:15 a.m. Opening Ceremony is in the Cafeteria. If you are not taking a first period class, you may skip the ceremony and report to registration fifteen minutes before your first session – please start at the check-in location.

Review pre-reqs carefully. For example, several badges require starting work in November 2018 to complete by Weekend 2 of Merit Badge College. The Prerequisite List is in the registration information and on the Council website. Prerequisites for Weekend 1 **must** be completed before the first Saturday, January 12th, 2019.

Parents, this is a drop and go event, as space is limited. The class rooms hold 20 Scouts; there is no room for observers. Pickup and drop off are in the same lot, come back when your Scout's last class is over. The location of the pickup and drop off lot is on the map with registration material.
