Deadline: May 1, 2017

Short-Term Research Grants support research stays in Germany between one and six months in length. Applicants must be either PhD candidates heading to Germany to work on their dissertation research or recent postdocs. In exceptional cases, holders of Master's or Bachelor degrees can be considered for this grant. Research Stays and Re-invitation Grants

Deadline: May 15, 2017

These programs support research stays of between one and three months in length for faculty at US and Canadian universities in any discipline who wish to pursue their research at a university, library, archive, institute or laboratory in Germany. 2017 Annual DAAD Contest: The Life of Martin Luther

In honour of the 500th anniversary of the Reformation, the theme of the **2017 DAAD Annual Contest** will be the major life events of **Martin Luther**, a theologian and thinker whose writings transformed religious institutions of 16th century Europe and fundamentally influenced the development of the German language.

The contest challenge consists of a timed, 15-question quiz with entrants scored on the basis of both accuracy and speed.

Only full-time students currently enrolled at a degree program at a North American university are eligible to participate. **Deadline for entries is April 18, 2017**. Full contest rules are [available here](#).

First prize is a free round-trip airfare to Germany, second prize is a GoPro Hero Camera and third prize is a \$50 gift card toward a book on Martin Luther.
