Green Talents Sustainable Development Award - Application Deadline: May 23rd



The German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) hosts the prestigious "**Green Talents – International Forum for High Potentials in Sustainable Development**" on a yearly basis to promote the international exchange of innovative green ideas. The award, under the patronage of Minister Professor Johanna Wanka, honours young researchers each year. The winners come from numerous countries and scientific disciplines and are recognised for their outstanding achievements in making our societies more sustainable. Selected by a high-ranking jury of German experts, the award-winners are granted unique access to the country's research elite through an extended research stay at a German research institute.

Applicants must be students enrolled in a Masters or a PhD program in any field related to sustainable development or must have completed their degree (Master/PhD) with significantly above-average grades in a similar program.

The **deadline for submissions** to this year's round is **May 23, 2017 at noon CEST**.
