





Part 3: Tuition and Payment

Your completed application must be accompanied with a non-refundable deposit, which will be credited against the cost of tuition, as follows:

K & 1: \$750 per learner

Grade 2-6: \$1,000 per learner

Grade 7-12: \$850 per learner

Hug Ivrit or Skype Tutoring: Payment in full

Registrations before Tuesday, June 6, 2017 qualifies you for an early discount (see above).

Registrations received between June 6 and July 31, 2017, payment is due in full by Tuesday, Aug 1, 2017.

Registrations received after Tuesday, August 1, 2017, payment in full is due at the time of registration.

A learner may not begin the school year unless Temple Israel Center has received payment in full.

Hug Ivrit and Skype Tutoring

Hug Ivrit and Skype Tutoring tuition are due in full at the time of registration.

Credit Card Payment

Credit card payments are accepted for full tuition payments only. Please keep in mind that payment by check rather than credit card saves TIC processing fees.

Absences or Voluntary Withdrawal

In the case of absences, school closings, or voluntary withdrawal, all tuition is non-refundable. Make-ups and adjustments will not be made. However, if the school director believes that your child is not benefiting from his or her experience, it is the School's privilege to request that the child be withdrawn. In such event, tuition will be pro-rated from the date of such withdrawal.
