About the instructor: Larry Conrad has been involved in the planning, organization, construction and operations of compost operations since the mid 1980's with the first fall leaf composting operation was started in the Region of Peel where he worked for over 34 years. During that time period he was responsible for the development of the composting capacity required to meet the requirements of the growing Region, including the design, construction and operations of three different compost plants. He has also been involved in the development of the markets for the finished compost in Ontario and has been a long time member of the Compost Council of Canada, currently serving as the National Chair. His teaching experience includes this course as well as several different courses for the Ontario chapter of SWANA.
