2. PNEC Conference Office, Palmerton will also accept buckets. Please call the conference office to arrange drop off at that location (610-826-3113).
3. Christ U.C.C. 460 Main Street in Conyngham, PA 18219 will accept completed buckets or kits. Please contact Pastor Sandy Murphy to arrange drop off at 570-956-4980 cell.



PNEC Disaster Ministries will transport the buckets and hygiene kits to Church World Service, New Windsor, Maryland. The first delivery date to CWS for buckets and kits will be in mid October. We hope that with this active hurricane season and other disasters, congregations will continue to make and collect kits over the next few months so that we can help Church World Service keep up with the demand.
