

PNEC Disaster Ministries Update

United Church of Christ Disaster Ministries is opening a volunteer work site in Port Arthur, Texas in early February. A partnership with Southeast Texas Community Development Corporation (SET CDC) has made this possible. The UCC has typically tried to serve the unserved communities after a disaster. In Port Arthur, FEMA provided significant assistance to families affected by Hurricane Harvey who were homeowners. The UCC partnership with SET CDC will provide help for apartments affected by the hurricane so that renters can get back to safe housing. The work that volunteers may be asked to do could include painting, flooring, light carpentry, drywall, insulation, and more. There is no cost for volunteers to stay in a newly renovated, large house in Beaumont, Texas for the week they volunteer. Volunteer weeks run from Sunday until Saturday morning. Kitchen facilities are available for volunteers to use to cook meals. There are also restaurants nearby. Beds/cots are available and volunteers would need to bring their own bedding. Groups that would like to take youth (16 and older) would be required to have a 1 adult to 4 youth ratio. Disaster ministries t-shirts will be given to volunteers!

The PNEC tool trailers are scheduled to arrive on site in Port Arthur, Texas in the beginning of February. The tools will be helpful to all the volunteers that answer the call to help our neighbors in Texas.
