What is the Foster Care Connection Mission? A Support Network for Foster Care Families

The United Methodist Children's Home started this program recently. The program's goal is to surround our church's foster families with a strong circle of volunteers and assistance so that they can focus on their family by receiving other support they may need.

How Can I Help? There are a LOT of ways!

You can do as little or as much as you want. Our church's foster care families have identified some areas where they would like assistance. For example: meals, store gift cards, prayer partners, and gently used clothes. Children often come to a foster care home with very little and the first few days or weeks can be hectic as everyone gets situated. Each family's needs may be different or change over time. Once you let us know how you are interested in helping, we will reach out to you when one of our families needs some help in an area you have indicated you are willing to serve.
